

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Enterprise North – 1 (EN-1) Project is a program to develop an onshore natural gas reservoir in the Victorian Otway Basin. ADZ Energy (ADZ) is seeking approval to undertake exploration drilling to determine the commercial viability for onshore gas field Petroleum Exploration Permit (PEP) 169. Should the EN-1 exploration well find commercial gas reserves, it will be converted to a production well with processed gas supplied into the domestic Victorian energy market. The well site will be located approximately 2.2 km west of Port Campbell, Victoria, and will be drilled on cleared, freehold grazing land in close proximity to existing pipeline infrastructure which will utilised for production.

PROJECT TIMING

The EN-1 Project is in the planning phase, conducting studies to finalise details. Preparatory works are scheduled to begin in the latter half of 2025, pending regulatory approvals. ADZ plans to issue a Notice of Operation Plan prior to submission of a preparatory works operation plan in the first half of 2025.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

EN-1 Project will use conventional natural gas drilling techniques and will not involve hydraulic stimulation (or 'fracking').

The five key stages of the EN-1 Project are:


Preparatory works (construction of a hardstand area (drill pad) and access tracks)

Drilling and completion of the gas well

Well surface facility construction including gathering into exisiting pipeline

Ongoing operation

Decommissioning and rehabilitation
